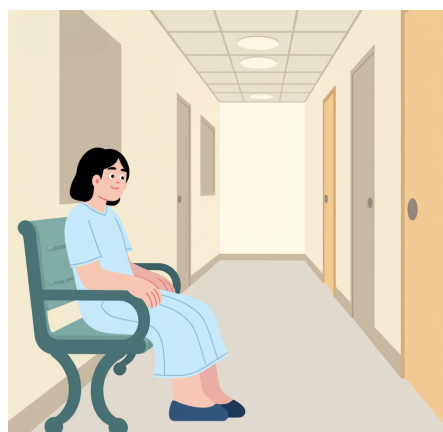


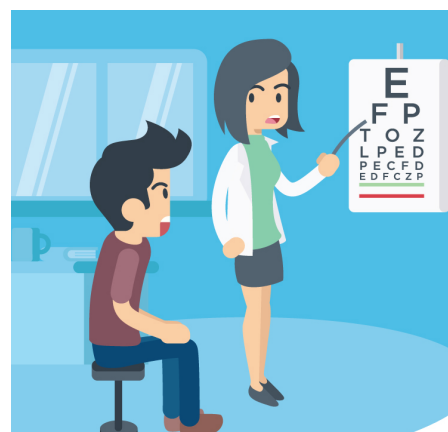
WHAT TO EXPECT AT MY DIABETIC EYE SCREENING APPOINTMENT

1. **On arrival, please wait in the waiting room:** We will call your name when it's your turn. Once called, we will proceed with our pre-screening questions.
2. **Visual acuity test:** Checks how clearly you can see at different distances by asking you to read letters or symbols on a chart.
3. **Dilated eye exam:** Eye drops are used to widen your pupils so the back of your eye can be examined for conditions like diabetic retinopathy and macular degeneration.
4. **Retinal photography:** Photos are taken of the back of your eye to help detect and monitor eye conditions, especially diabetic retinopathy.
5. **Discussion of results:** Your images will be reviewed, and you should receive results within **3 weeks**. Your GP will also get the results and advise on any next steps if needed.
